Situated in picturesque Lorton Valley, near Loweswater in the North Lake District, St Cuthbert's is the quintessential rural English parish church.

The new Rodgers organ in St Cuthbert's was installed in November 2006 and is a small, simple 2 manual organ, with lighted stop-tabs. It contains internal speakers as well as a two-channel, full range external audio system positioned at high level in the chancel.

The installation was carried out by Rodgers Partner, Creighton & Tweedie in Penrith, and tonal finishing by Mark Underwood of Rodgers UK. The organ was opened in a concert given by international recitalist, Ian Hare.
