

Llandaff Cathedral, Cardiff

Rodgers Custom T967, 3 manuals & pedals



The pipe organ in Llandaff Cathedral has been in a steady decline for some years and, in February 2007, a lightning strike caused terminal damage to the internal electrics rendering the instrument unusable. A brand new pipe organ is planned for completion in 2011, and in the meantime, a Rodgers Trillium 967 has been chosen to lead the worship.

Llandaff is the only Cathedral in Wales to have a full-time choral foundation and dedicated choir school; consequently, the Dean and Chapter were keen to choose a temporary instrument of suitable standard, fit for the rigours of the Cathedral's daily service schedule.

The Trillium 967 (which has been loaned to the Cathedral from BBC Wales) was installed by the UK Rodgers team, with the console sitting proudly at the base of Epstein's statue, *Christ in Majesty*. The audio system is located in a gallery on the south side of the choir, with the speakers carefully positioned to recreate the geography of an equivalent pipe organ. Tonal finishing was carried out by Mark Underwood from Rodgers UK in conjunction with Richard Moorhouse, the Cathedral Organist and Master of the Choristers.
